

## SURREY JUNIOR FLOWER ARRANGERS

### STEP-BY-STEP DESIGN - TABLE DESIGN (floral foam free)

#### YOU WILL NEED

- A sheet of corrugated card approx. 24-30cm square or rectangular - sharp scissors or a scalpel to cut your rounds out of the card -
- Spray paint, brush paint, brown paper, fancy wrapping paper, handmade paper, newspaper - or whatever you wish to use - in order to cover your corrugated card on both sides -
- Clean dessert pots - however many you wish to use in your design -
- Craft glue - and Uhu / Bostik / Oasis adhesive glue for joining the pots securely to the corrugated card -
- Decoration for your corrugated card, such as buttons, small cones, ribbon or string, fancy stickers - and even a candle or two for a special celebration -
- Flowers and foliage - a selection of small flowers and complementary foliage in your preferred colour scheme -



#### INSTRUCTIONS

- Prepare your corrugated card, cut out the rounds for your dessert pots -
- Cover your card neatly with your paper or paint - tearing small irregular pieces of paper gives an effective texture, gluing carefully ensuring you cover your card -
- Spray or brush paint your pots, or cover with paper to disguise their original use -
- Glue the pots to the 'underside' of your corrugated card, using the Uhu/Bostik/Oasis glue and leave to dry securely -



- Pour a little water into your pots then place your short stem flowers and foliages into the pots - watching out for any plant material leaves that tend to siphon off water then making your corrugated card wet - be watchful of that -
- Decorate the top of your card around your little flower pots with buttons, curly wires, small cones, stickers, or whatever other decoration you wish to use -



This design would be pretty for a special lunch with your family, or just for the dining table at home - or with a candle inserted in the centre of the design -
