Class 1: EARTH

An Exhibit

Staged on a flat surface, space allowed: 80cm, depth 60cm, height optional, against a background of exhibitor's choice.

Class 2: WATER

An Exhibit

Staged on a flat surface, space allowed: width 80cm, depth 60cm, height optional, against a background of exhibitor's choice.

Class 3: FIRE

An Exhibit

Staged on a flat surface, space allowed: width 80cm, depth 60cm, height optional, against background of exhibitor's choice.

Class 4: AIR

An Exhibit

Staged on a flat surface, space allowed: width 80cm, depth 60cm, height optional, against background of exhibitor's choice.

Class 5: SPACE

An Exhibit

Staged on a flat surface, space allowed: width 80cm, depth 60cm, height optional, against a background of exhibitor's choice.

INFORMATION AND REGULATIONS

1. The competition is open to all members of WAFA.
2. The competition will be judged under WAFA rules.
3. The show will be judged by accredited Judges from WAFA member countries.
4. Exhibits should be the original, unaided work of the competitor and not have been entered previously on any forum.
5. Places in each class are limited to 16 entries and must be pre- applied for through <https://www.munsteragriculturalsociety.com/our-events/floral-art-competitions>
6. Entries will be accepted on a first come first served basis.
7. Exhibit photograph is to be submitted between 1st November (09.00 GMT) and 6th November (17.00 GMT) to n.desmond@munsteragriculturalsociety.com stating Name, Class Number and Contact Number (WhatsApp) if available.
8. The photograph must be in clear, high resolution, jpeg format and must not be enhanced in any way. Cropping of surroundings is permitted.
9. Competitors may enter as many classes as they wish but may not stage more than one entry per class.
10. Competitors unable to fulfil their commitment to enter must notify the Show Administrator n.desmond@munsteragriculturalsociety.com in advance of the show.
11. Comments will be sent to each individual competitor and will not be published.
12. Exhibits may not be posted on social media until after the release of results.
13. By entering the competition, you are agreeing to allow an image of your design be published and named on social media.
14. The Judges' decision is final.

International World Flower Show Rules

- An exhibit is made of plant material, with or without accessories, according to the space specified in the show schedule.
- Plant material must predominate over all other components of the exhibit.
- The use of artificial plant material is forbidden unless otherwise stated in the schedule.
- Painted and/or artificially coloured plant material may be used unless otherwise stated in the schedule.
- Fresh plant material must be in water or in water-retaining material unless such material remains turgid.
