

SHOW SCHEDULE 2026

CLASS 1. 'A MIDSUMMER NIGHT'S DREAM'

INTER-SOCIETY CLASS. An Exhibit. Space

allowed: W=100cm. D=100cm. H=180cm. Staged by up to two members of the same club. Staged on a wooden floor (or clubs may use their own base) against a grey draped background. Viewed and judged from the front.

CLASS 2. 'SITTING PRETTY': A Decorated Chair

(chair provided by exhibitor). To be staged on a square base 100cm x 100cm painted green. Height max. 150cm. Viewed and judged all round.

CLASS 3. 'DREAMCATCHER': A Craft Exhibit.

Space allowed: W=30cm. D=30cm. H=max 60cm. May be brought ready assembled including a loop suitable to be hung from a tree branch. Viewed and judged all round.

CLASS 4. 'AWAY WITH THE FAIRIES': A Petite Exhibit.

Space allowed: W=25cm. D=25cm. H=max. 37.5cm. Staged on a grey draped base and in grey individual niches placed on the front of the stage. May be brought ready assembled. Viewed and judged from the front.

CLASS 5. 'A SUMMER MEADOW': A Meadow Style Exhibit.

Space allowed: W=90cm. D=68cm. H=max 110cm. Staged on grey draped tabling and background. Viewed and judged from the front.

CLASS 6. 'PICNIC TIME': A Still Life Exhibit.

Space allowed: W=90cm. D=68cm. H=max 90cm. Staged on grey draped tabling. Viewed all round but judged from the front.

CLASS 7. 'A JUNE WEDDING': A Pedestal Exhibit.

Space allowed: W=100cm. D=100cm. H= max 180cm. Floor placements are allowed. Staged on a round 90cm diameter base painted green with a grey draped background. Viewed and judged from the front.

CLASS 8. 'SUMMER'S BOUNTY': An Exhibit to

include fruit and/or vegetables. Space allowed: W=90 cm. D=68cm. H=max. 110cm. Staged on grey draped tabling and background. Viewed and judged from the front.

CLASS 9. 'MIDSUMMER SOLSTICE': A Craft

Collage to be done on board (with eye hooks for hanging) to be provided on entry. Must be hand made with plant material. To be hung on pale blue wall. May be brought ready assembled, landscape format.

CLASS 10. 'IT'S A BARBEQUE': An Exhibit. ONLY

Open to male members and male relations of AFDC. Space allowed: W=60cm. D=68cm. H=max. 90cm. Staged on grey draped tabling. Viewed and judged from the front. May be brought ready assembled. Each Exhibit to be numbered with no name shown. This class will be judged by the Public on paper voting slip placed in box provided.

Key: W= Width, D= Depth, H= Height.

Note: Please consider other competitors when staging your exhibit as space in the hall is limited. Any water spillage or drips must be wiped up and dried immediately as it stains the wood block flooring and you might be liable to a charge.

Regulations:

1. All the classes except Class 1 and 10 are open only to individual members of Aldershot Floral Design Club.
2. Entries on official forms must reach the Show Secretary between 20th March & 19th April 2026. The Show Committee reserves the right to limit the number of entries in each class. Should a class be over-subscribed, entries will be allocated by a ballot. In order to avoid empty spaces competitors are requested to notify any cancellations to the Show Secretary (Janet Arm 01252-783133) as soon as possible.
3. No Exhibitor may be allowed to enter more than three classes unless classes are not filled.
4. Class 1 may be staged between 2pm and 7pm on Friday 19th June. All other classes are to be staged between 2pm and 9pm on that day.
5. Exhibits must be staged within the space allowed and must be the competitor's own original work, not previously exhibited in its entirety. All exhibits except Classes 3,4,9 and 10 must be assembled at the Show.
6. No aerosol sprays will be allowed in the hall.
7. All exhibits: Personal property etc. shall be at the risk of the exhibitor. The Show Committee and Normandy Village Hall shall not be liable for any loss or damage from any cause. Every precaution will be taken to safeguard exhibits.
8. Exhibits will be judged in accordance with the NAFAS Competition Manual Fourth Edition (2023). All classes will be judged using 1st, 2nd, 3rd, VHC, HC, and C awards. The Judges decision will be final.
9. Tabling is 71cm high and the draped background height will be 190cm from the floor. These measurements are approximate. All tabling and drapes are light grey and the paint colour is Dulux Mineral Haze 1 or Lime Zest 3 (colour swatch to be sent for classes 2 and 7)
10. Prize Giving will be on Saturday 20th June at 4.30pm. Monetary prizes will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd exhibits in Class 1: "A Midsommer Night's Dream" (Inter-Society) with an AFDC Trophy to the winner. Hampshire Dish and Men's Class decided by popular vote.
11. Exhibits and Judges' Comment Cards must remain in place and must not be removed from the hall until the end of the Show.
