


## Class 1 Green Planet An Inter-Society Class

Space allowed: 90cm width x 90cm depth x height optional. Staged on the mid oak floor with a pale pink curtain background. To include an orchid in memory of Joan Cooper. Viewed and judged from the front. 1 or 2 members nominated by their Club may stage this exhibit.




#### **Class 2 Patterns in Nature**

Space allowed: 85cm width x 75cm depth x height optional. Staged on tabling with pale grey drape against off-white background. Viewed and judged from the front.



## Class 3 Diversity An exhibit featuring foliage


Space allowed: 80cm diameter x height optional. Staged on pale grey base 80cm diameter on floor with off-white background. Viewed and Judged from the front.



## Class 4 Bee Friendly Barbara Newell Class

Space allowed: 70cm width x 60cm depth x 90cm height. Staged on tabling with pale grey drape against pale grey backing. Viewed and judged from the front.

This class is open ONLY to members who have not previously entered an Area Show. Demonstrators, teachers and judges are excluded from this class.




### Class 5 Frozen

#### **Novice class**


Space allowed: 85cm width x 75cm depth x 120cm height. Staged on tabling with pale grey drape against pale grey backing. Viewed and judged from the front.

This class is open ONLY to members who have not won a first, second or third award in an Area show.



## Class 6 Playing with Colour A hanging exhibit to include item(s) from the recycling bin


Space allowed: 25cm width x 25cm depth x 100cm height. Staged against an off-white wall to hang from a hook, provided, 180cm from the floor. May be brought ready assembled. Viewed and judged from the front.

#### Class 7 Sticks and Stones


Space allowed: 50cm width x 50cm depth x 120cm height. Staged on a pale grey solid block 50cm width x 50cm depth x 50cm height against pale pink curtain background. Viewed and judged from the front.



#### Class 10 Sunrise


#### A Collage

Space allowed: 60cm width x 6cm depth x 42cm height – A2 size. Staged hanging against the off-white wall. See note 6 in Staging Regulations. **Must** be brought ready assembled.



#### Class 8 Reach for the Stars


Space allowed: 40cm width x 40cm depth x height optional. Staged on a pale grey solid block 40cm width x 40cm depth x 60cm height. Viewed and judged all round.



## Class 11 Over the Edge


#### A miniature exhibit

Space allowed: 10cm width x 10cm depth x 15cm height. Staged on a 10cm high block on a wooden board 10cm x 10cm on a table 120cm from floor. See note 6 in Staging Regulations. Viewed all round and judged from the front. May be brought ready assembled.



### Class 9 Watery World

Space allowed: 60cm width x 60cm depth x 90cm height. Staged on a pale grey board 60cm x 60cm on tabling with pale grey drape and pale grey backing. Viewed and judged from the front.

## **Staging Regulations**

- 1. Only competitors and officials will be allowed in the hall during staging.
- 2. Staging will be on Friday 12 July 8am 12 noon. All competitors must vacate the building by 12 noon.
- 3. Judging will be on Friday 12 July 2.00 6.00pm.
- 4. Dismantling will be on Saturday 13 July 4.00pm 4.30pm.
- 5. All measurements in the staging description are **approximate** and the **diagrams are not to scale**. Tables are about 75cm high.
- 6. In classes 10 and 11 the staging will be available in advance for purchase: Class 10 £3; Class 11 50p. Details on acceptance of place.
- 7. Natural plant material must predominate in all exhibits. No artificial plant material may be used.
- 8. Aerosol sprays and glue guns may not be brought into or used anywhere on the premises, inside or outside. Nothing may be attached to the Area staging in any class.
- Please remember that the venue is a Church Hall. The walls are painted offwhite and the floor is medium grey carpet or light wood. For more information and to see the venue website please visit https://sgsgashtead.org.uk/venue-hire.

## Regulations

- 1. Only members of Clubs and Societies affiliated to the Surrey Area of NAFAS may compete.
- 2. Entries must be received between Monday 13 May and Saturday 25 May 2024. An individual competitor may enter up to two classes.
- 3. Enter using the instructions on the entry form.
- 4. Any class oversubscribed will be balloted.
- 5. All entries are to be regarded as exhibits.
- 6. All exhibits will be judged in accordance with this schedule and the NAFAS Competitions Manual Fourth Edition (2023). The Judges' decision is final.
- 7. An exhibit must be staged within the space allowed. It must be the competitor's own work and not previously exhibited.
- 8. Exhibits must be assembled at the venue. Exceptions are Classes 6 and 11 which may be brought ready assembled and 10 which **must** be brought ready to hang. The competitor is expected to use the staging time to complete their exhibit but any items requiring time or expertise for their preparation (pre-done work) may be used.
- 9. All exhibits and competitor's property will be at the risk of the competitor.

  Neither the Area nor the Owners of The Dell Centre, or any part of them, can accept any liability whatsoever for any loss or damage.
- 10. The Surrey Area reserves the right to use photographs of any exhibit for any purpose.
- 11. Class 1 will not be included for consideration in the award for Best Individual Exhibit in Show.
