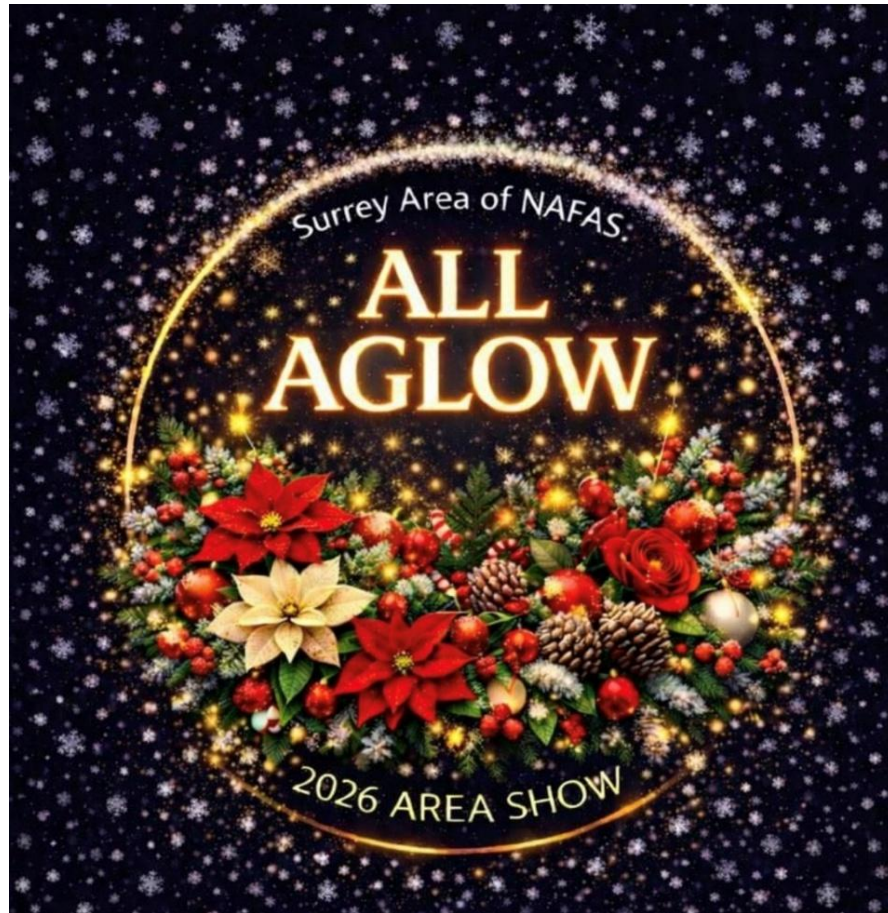

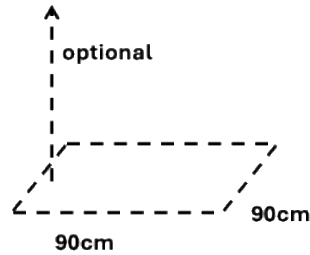
Floral Art Schedule

All classes in this schedule are to be regarded as exhibits.

Class 1 Panto Time

An Inter-Society Class

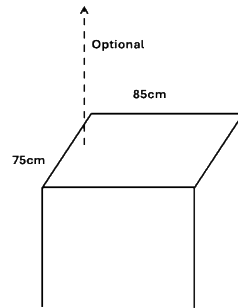
Space allowed: 90cm width x 90cm depth x height optional. Staged on the mid oak floor with a bright red curtain background. Pantomime to be named. Viewed and judged from the front. 1 or 2 members nominated by their Club may stage this exhibit.



Class 2 Silent Night

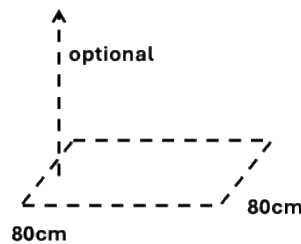
A Landscape exhibit

Space allowed: 85cm width x 75cm depth x height optional. Staged on tabling with green drape against off-white background. Viewed and judged from the front.



Class 3 Seasonal Sculpture

Space allowed: 80cm width x 80cm depth x height optional. Staged on light oak floor with off-white background. Viewed and judged from the front.

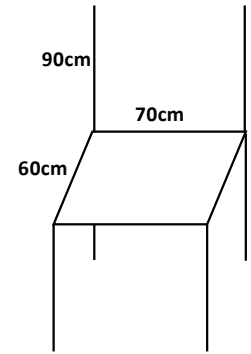


Class 4 Cones and Candles

Novice Class

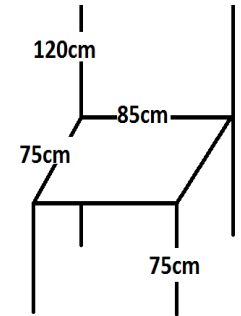
Space allowed: 70cm width x 60cm depth x 90cm height. Staged on tabling with green drape against green backing. Viewed and judged from the front.

This class is open to members who have not won a first, second or third award at an Area or National Show. Demonstrators, teachers and judges are excluded.



Class 5 All Aglow

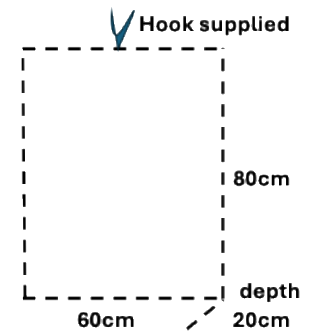
Space allowed: 85cm width x 75cm depth x height 120cm. Staged on tabling with green drape against green backing. Viewed and judged from the front.



Class 6 Festive Welcome

A seasonal door hanging

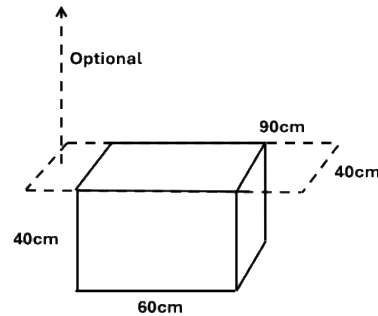
Space allowed: 60cm width x 20cm depth x 80cm height. Must be brought ready done with a hanging loop, to hang against an off-white door background. Viewed and judged from the front.



Class 7 On Thin Ice

A horizontal layered design

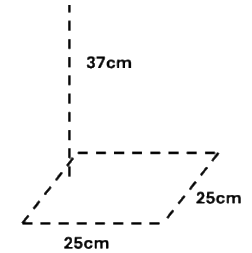
Space allowed: 90cm width x 40cm depth x height optional. Staged on a pale grey painted solid block 60cm width x 40cm depth x 40cm height, placed on a table with green drape and green backing. Viewed and judged from the front.



Class 10 Oh, Christmas Tree

A Petite exhibit

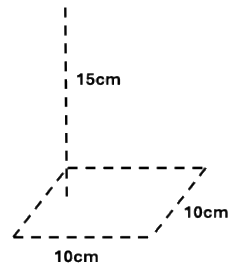
Space allowed: 25cm width x 25cm depth x 37cm height. Staged on tabling with green drape against pale green backing. May be brought ready done. Viewed and judged from the front.



Class 8 Good Things Come in Small Packages

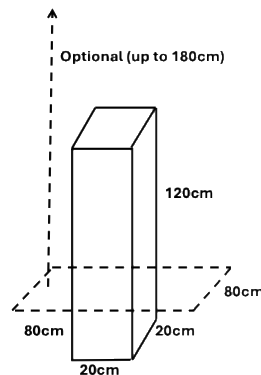
A miniature exhibit

Space allowed: 10cm width x 10cm depth x 15cm height. Staged on a pale grey painted table 120cm high. May be brought ready done. Viewed and judged from the front.



Class 9 Party Time

Space allowed: 80cm width x 80cm depth x height optional. Staged on a pale grey painted plinth 20cm width x 20cm depth x 120 height. No floor placements are allowed and plant material must be at least 20cm above the floor. Viewed and judged all round.

Staging Regulations

1. Only competitors and officials will be allowed in the hall during staging.
2. Staging will be on Friday 27 November 8am – 12 noon. All competitors must vacate the building by 12 noon.
3. Judging will be on Friday 27 November 2.00 – 6.00pm.
4. Dismantling will be on Saturday 28 November 4.00pm – 4.30pm.
5. All measurements in the staging description are **approximate** and the **diagrams are not to scale**. Tables are about 75cm high.
6. Artificial plant material may be used in Classes 1, 6 and 9. Natural plant material must predominate in all exhibits.
7. Aerosol sprays and glue guns may not be brought into or used anywhere on the premises, inside or outside. Nothing may be attached to the Area staging in any class.
8. Please remember that the venue is a Church Hall and respect the furnishings, carpet etc. The walls are painted off-white and the floor is medium grey carpet or light wood. For more information and to see the venue website please visit <https://sgsgashtead.org.uk/venue-hire>.

Regulations

1. Only members of Clubs and Societies affiliated to the Surrey Area of NAFAS may compete. Members of Surrey Designer Clubs are encouraged to compete. However, those who are members of both a Design Club and a local Surrey Club may only compete on behalf of their local Flower Club. This regulation does not apply to Class 1. The Designer Clubs are Focus 2000, Southern Demonstrators and Winkworth Floral Designers.
2. Entries must be received between Monday 28 September and Saturday 12 October 2026. An individual competitor may enter up to three classes.
3. Enter online using the instructions on the entry form.
4. Any class oversubscribed will be balloted.
5. All exhibits will be judged in accordance with this schedule and the NAFAS Competitions Manual Fourth Edition (2023). The Judges' decision is final.
6. An exhibit must be staged within the space allowed. It must be the competitor's own work and not previously exhibited.
7. Exhibits must be assembled at the venue. Exceptions are Classes 8 and 10 which may be brought ready assembled and 6 which **must** be brought ready to hang. The competitor is expected to use the staging time to complete their exhibit but any items requiring time for their preparation (pre-done work) may be used but must not predominate.
8. All exhibits and competitor's property will be at the risk of the competitor. Neither the Area nor the Owners of The Dell Centre, or any part of them, can accept any liability whatsoever for any loss or damage.
9. The Surrey Area reserves the right to use photographs of any exhibit for any purpose.
10. Class 1 will not be included for consideration in the award for Best Individual Exhibit in Show.
