Today 65 years on, we meet in the Regent Hall, Albert Road, Horley on the first Tuesday evening of each month at 7.30pm. To mark the anniversary, we held a special event on our April club night. The evening started with a delicious buffet meal that was catered by the committee where we raised a glass to toast the fun and friendship we have had, over the years, coming together to enjoy our shared interest in flowers. The chairman Janet Aslett made a short speech and a celebration cake was cut by our longest standing member, Pam Lee, who had joined the club back in 1974.
